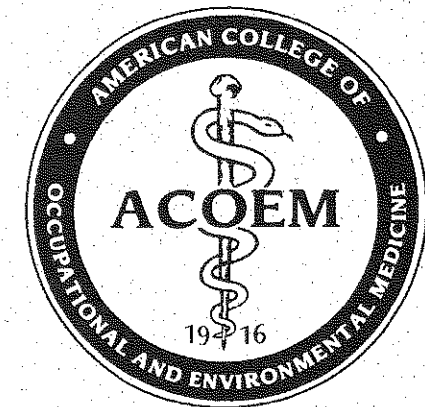
Spouse Tour
